Note that two of the sixteen children listed below bore the given name 'Caroline'; the second Caroline being the great-grandmother of the compiler of this note.

Rufus and Caroline lived most of their married life in Adams, NY, where they were interred in Elmwood Cemetery.

That bible is now in the possession of Marian (Ripley) Steele, the widow of the late Frank Steele of Adams, NY, who was a descendant of John and Catherine (Van Wormer) Rockwell.
